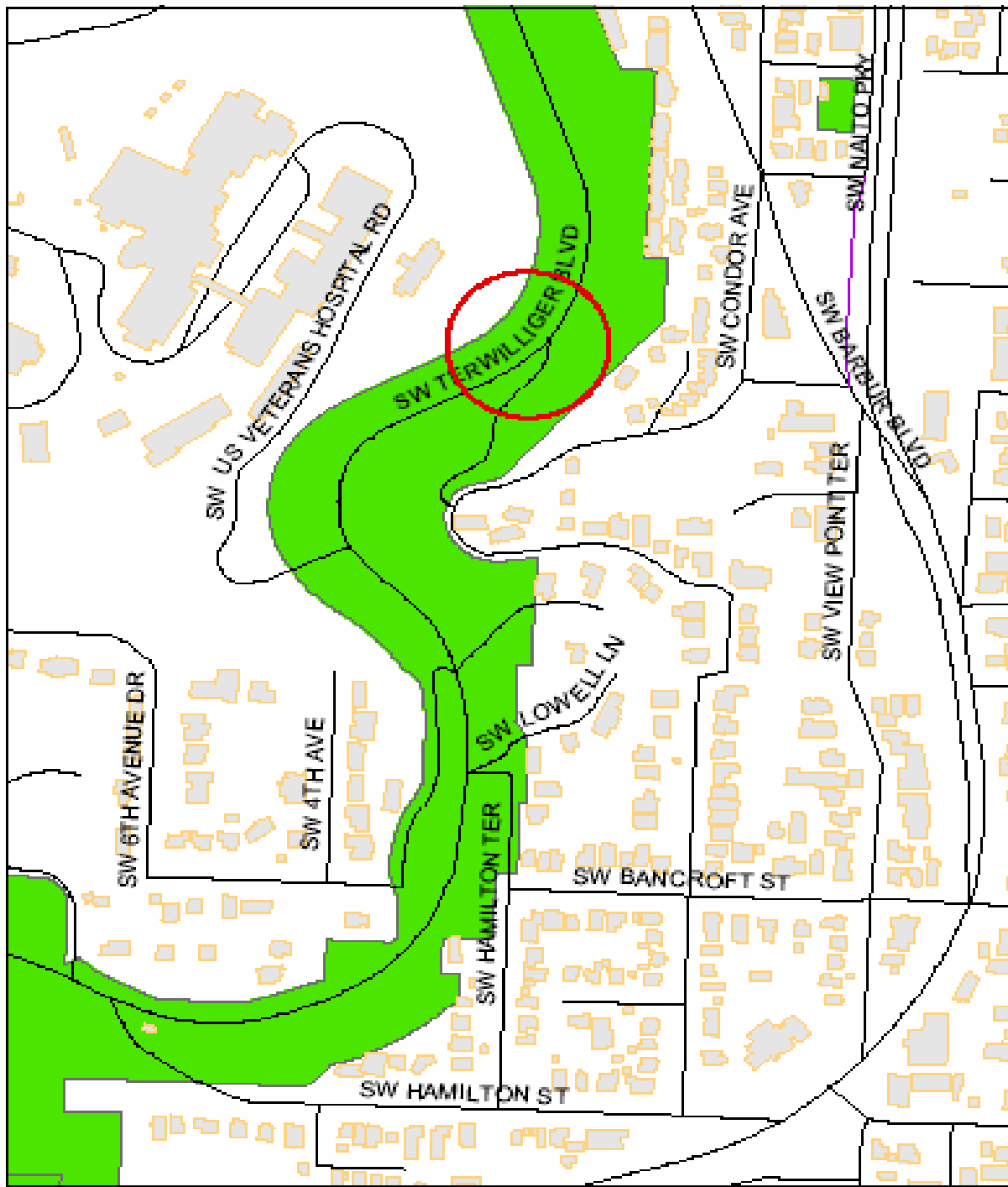

Problem:

Innocuous-looking intersection poses danger to cyclists

- Northbound cyclists travel downhill at motor vehicle speeds (25 mph).
- Motorists misjudge bike speed and tend to pull out in front of cyclists.
- Cut-through traffic creates volume at poorly designed intersection.
- Crash data lacking but many anecdotal reports including three hip fractures.





Proposed Solution

- Vacate Condor Lane to motor vehicle traffic while continuing bike/pedestrian access.
- Propose solution during development of plans to address mandated OHSU traffic mitigation measures.
