# Current Permeability

# Problem

- Lack of permeability in the King Neighborhood
- The neighborhood tends to be severed by MLK Blvd
- Lack of foot traffic traveling East to West and North to South at the intersection of MLK Blvd and NE Alberta



# Solution

- Enhanced crosswalks on the North, South, East and West sides of the intersection of MLK Blvd and NE Alberta

# Accessability

- Add 4 Handicapped Accessible curb domes, 2 per corner for a total of 8

- Historic markers at two corners honoring the cultural heritage of the neighborhood





# Budget

- Crosswalks 4 x \$1000
- Curb Domes 8 x \$500
- Historic Markers 2 x \$1500
- Planters 2 x \$1500
- Miscellaneous \$5000
  
- Total Project Cost =\$19,000

# Major Barriers

- MLK Blvd is a major trucking artery
- The crosswalk work would likely be done in four stages, one crosswalk per night, four nights total
- Two of those nights would be disruptive to trucking, trucks would have to be rerouted
